



QUICK-START GUIDE

Rat Zapper *Classic*

Battery Compartment:

The **Rat Zapper** battery compartment is located on the top of the unit. To open, pull the securing tap back then lift the battery compartment door. Properly install 4 “AA” batteries in the battery holder and re-secure the lid to the battery compartment.

Important Information: The performance of your **Rat Zapper** will depend upon the:

- 1) Quality of batteries;
- 2) Amount of time your **Rat Zapper** is turned on;
- 3) Number of rodents killed;
- 4) Cleanliness of the unit floor.

Rating	Battery Type	Expected Use
BEST	Energizer E2 Lithiums	These batteries cost more, but have a much longer life than others and great performance. 30-plus kills.
GOOD	Duracell Ultras with M3 Technology or Energizer E2 Titaniums	These batteries provide up to 10 kills and/or about 30 days of use.
FAIR	Alkaline Batteries	These batteries have an even more limited life and fewer kills per set than all the others.
NO!!	Heavy Duty, Super Heavy Duty, Extra Heavy Duty, Carbon Zinc, non- alkaline	Will NOT work in the Rat Zapper!
NO!!	NiCad (Nickel Cadmium) or NMH Rechargeables	Will NOT work in the Rat Zapper!
OPTION	Rat Zapper <i>Ultra</i> model offers as many kills as E2 Lithiums with less costly D-cell batteries	Great for larger rodent infestations.

What does the red light on the Rat Zapper mean?

There are two uses for the red light on the Rat Zapper.

- 1) **Battery Check-** When you turn the **Rat Zapper** power switch to the **ON** position, the red light will blink brightly once, then turn off. If the light is dim or does not turn on at all, replace the batteries. (See chart above for Recommended Batteries.)
- 2) **Rodent Check-** The **Rat Zapper** red light will blink **repeatedly** when you've killed a rodent. (*NOTE: A blinking red light with no rodent inside may indicate moisture has caused “false trip” of the unit or that the unit requires cleaning*)

INSTRUCTIONS FOR CLEANING (Remove batteries first!)

When dust, dirt or other contaminants accumulate in the **Rat Zapper**, you will need to clean the unit, otherwise it may trigger a false trip, causing the red light to blink repeatedly when you turn it on.

1. Remove batteries before cleaning to insure safety.
2. Obtain an inexpensive, thin aluminum pan large enough in width and length to accommodate the **Rat Zapper**.
3. Fill the pan with approximately 1 inch of warm/hot water, a tablespoon of vinegar and an ample amount of dish detergent. Set the **Rat Zapper** in the pan and let it soak for approximately 1 hour (to loosen debris.)
4. Using a soft bristle or bottle brush, commonly found in the cookware section of your local supermarket, gently brush the bottom of your **Rat Zapper**.
5. To rinse, carefully allow a gentle stream of fresh water to flow over the cleaned bottom surface of the **Rat Zapper**. Do not spray the unit out or allow moisture to intrude into the electronics that are housed in the top of the **Rat Zapper** as this may cause the electronics to short out and impair the unit's performance.
6. After cleaning and rinsing the bottom of the **Rat Zapper** thoroughly, place it with the open side face down to allow the **Rat Zapper** to drain and air dry completely (do not use air compressor) before putting it back into service (about 2 to 3 hours).

RECOMMENDATIONS FOR OUTDOOR USE TO MINIMIZE THE CHANCE OF FALSE TRIPS AND DAMAGE TO THE ELECTRONICS

- For continuous use outdoors purchase a **Rat Zapper Rat's Nest** (Our *Rat's Nest* housing is designed to protect your **Rat Zapper** from water and other elements).
- A temporary solution for the outdoor use of the **Rat Zapper** is to place it under a weather-proof-tarp, or cover it with a plastic freezer bag, leaving only the entry uncovered. Secure the plastic bag to the **Rat Zapper** with a rubber band.
